## From our Exhibition





In cooperation with product design and computer science students at the Berlin School of Art and Design and the Free University of Berlin, CityLAB will open the exhibition "**Entity:City**" on February 12. During the winter semester 2019/20, the students formed interdisciplinary teams which explored challenges currently being faced by Berlin's urban space and its inhabitants\* and developed and tested neo-analogue products to address these challenges. The project uses data generated by the actors and systems in Berlin and returns these data to the physical space they originated from, resulting in new forms of participation and interaction.
