The ultimate review: our 2023 summer party




prototyping: these are the new exhibits you can look forward to!

The four exhibits have one thing in common – they all make use of the possibilities of artificial intelligence! Before you try them out for yourself on a visit, we'll give you a brief introduction here:

While you look deep into the camera's eyes, the artificial intelligence on the other side draws inspiration to create a work of art via facial recognition. The result is a portrait with a difference – which you can even take home with you as a souvenir. Since the format was so well received at our summer party, we are currently working on a technical solution for permanent use. So you'll have to be patient for a while – as soon as you can get blown off, you'll be the first to know here.



The Kiezbot: probably the most unusual chatbot crew in the world Our three chatbot personalities Ernst, Kiki and Roki already talked their heads off at our summer party: now they've recharged their batteries and are ready and waiting for you in the *Kiezlabor*. From August 16 to 27 you can visit the fun trio on Tempelhofer Feld. Supported by ChatGPT, each of the three is a true expert in their field: Kiki the bee knows all there is to know about climate protection in the city, robot Roki is up-to-date on the latest technology crazes, and Ernst the Currywurst, as a true Berliner, has more to say than just grumble about his home city. We hope you have fun trying it out!

Plan your Kiezlabor visit



After the official opening at the summer party, our *Kiezlabor* will be hitting Tempelhof-Neukölln next – directly on Tempelhofer Feld alongside Tempelhofer Dam near the Luftschloss. The program will be green: we're going to focus on the topic of climate, so we invite you to engage in direct dialog on the subject of urban greenery and trees on August 17. As with any good *Kiezlabor* program, prototypes will definitely be part of the set-up this time, too – in **developing these** we'll be drawing inspiration from visions of the future for Tempelhofer Feld itself. In addition, we look forward to getting actively involved in the citizens' fair on 19 August. We will also have watering and moisture sensors on board: find out in the Kiezlabor what exactly these do and to what extent they help preserve Berlin's green infrastructure! We'll be posting program details on our website soon, so feel free to take a look and sign up for the individual workshops as the mood takes you! We look forward to seeing you there!
