#### Privacy and Mobility 2023

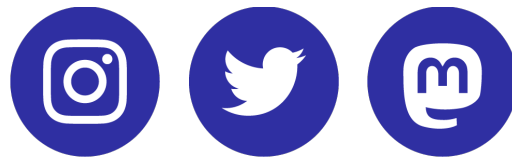
from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

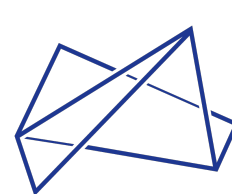
