





#### First stop: The Rollbergsiedlung gets rolling

Berlin Neukölln, Rollbergsiedlung

How can participation, neighbourhood and local structures be strengthened when neighbourhoods change? After Poppele-Platz in Reinickendorf, the *Kiezlabor* has two more locations on the agenda – with new focal points and ideas that will be developed together with the neighbourhood. From 14 to 16 July, the *Kiezlabor* will be on the road in Neukölln on a cargo bike. Together with residents, local initiatives and the administration, we will literally get topics such as environmental education, public spaces and digital participation rolling. The focus is on the question of how existing conflicts can be reduced and sustainable structures anchored at the same time – especially in view of the approaching end of neighbourhood management in 2027.
