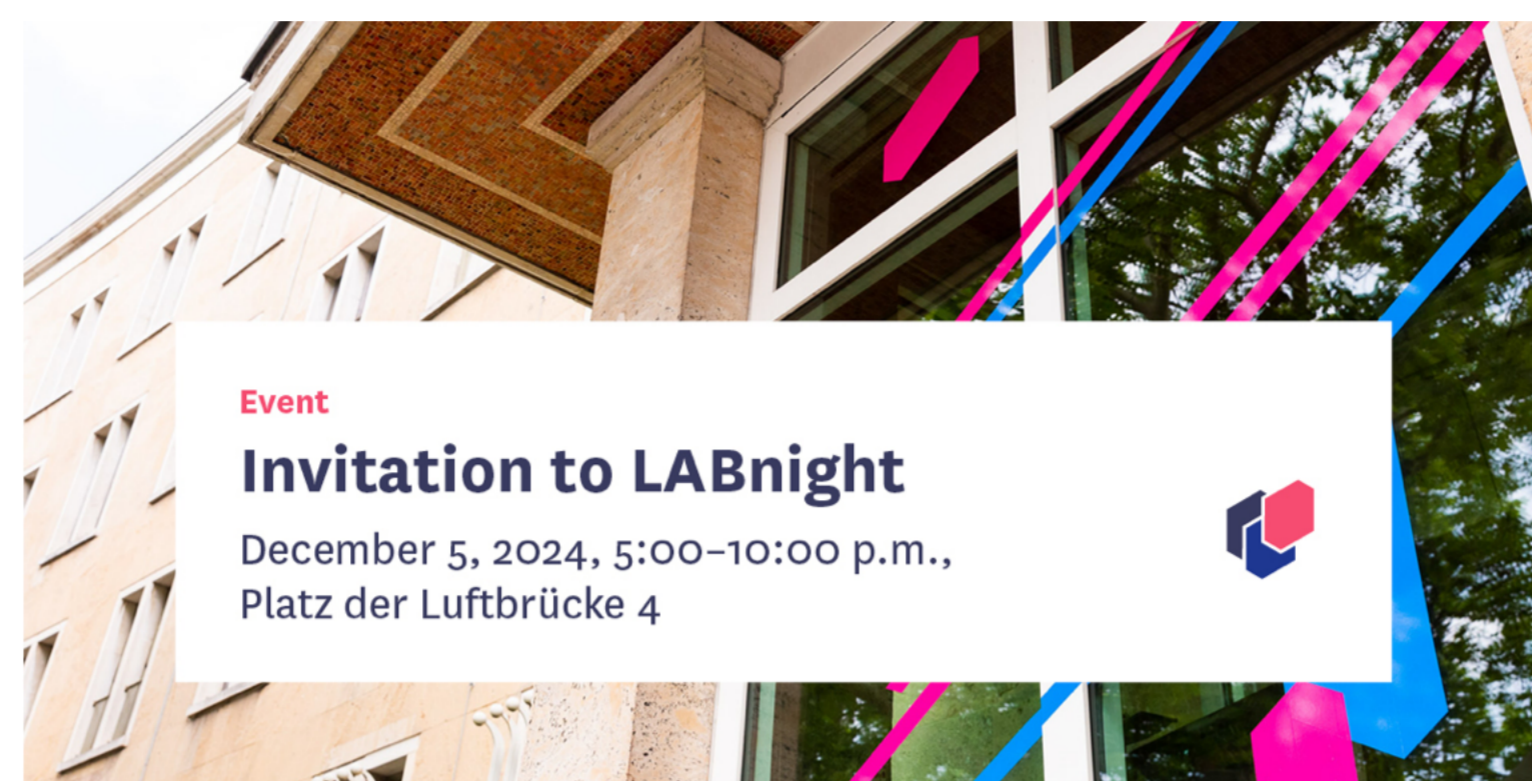

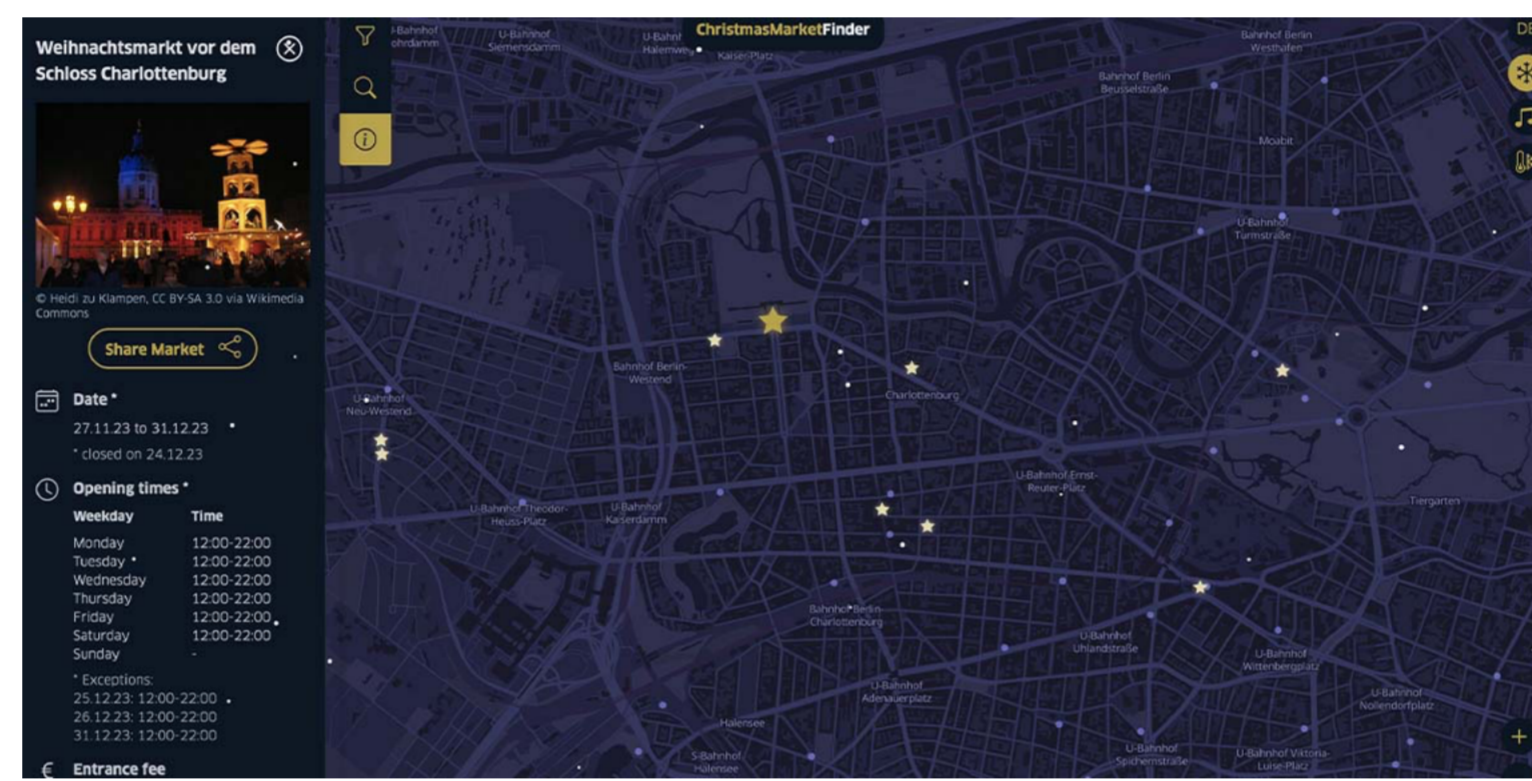


Event **LABnight 2024**
